### Item description/summary:

Water shutoff update: The moratorium on termination of water service to residential customers and small businesses for nonpayment was extended from Sept. 30, 2021 to December 2021 with SB 155. No information about another extension is readily available and shutoffs are planned to commence in July 2022 unless staff receives a stop order from the District's legal counsel. 125 accounts are past due 60 days or more. The largest outstanding balance of these accounts is \$1,284, and the average balance is \$273.
