



## **General Manager Report of Activities for May/June 2019**

**June 27, 2019**

Project	Progress This Period
Building Permits	We have had 43 since the beginning of June.
Annexation – Sports, Entertainment and Industrial	CEQA process, annexation map creation and detailed engineering study for collections route and cost are all underway.
Casino	We are starting to prepare for the operational phase of our contract with the tribe. We will schedule a true-up with the tribe soon. Opening day in late October.
Ad-Hoc Committees	Provided staff support to several OPUD Ad-Hoc committees.
IRWMP Grants	We continue to attend the meetings and the group adopted the plan (Integrated Regional Water Management Plan) which will be submitted to DWR. Once approved by DWR, our Board will need to adopt the plan to receive grant funding from the state. We will have a few projects we'd like to submit: steel main replacement, water meter project and intertie with Linda County Water. The consultant will meet with OPUD staff to talk about grant opportunities soon. The state funding for this grant for our area has decreased significantly. We may have to phase the steel main replacement project.
Parks Grants	We are working on grants through OGALS (State) for grants in the Olivehurst community park and the Plumas Lake area community park. We are in the process of holding the public meetings discussing the two parks.
OPUD Pool	Pool is in operation. The original pump failed and we had a new one installed. The pool was closed for a couple days while the new pump was installed.
Community Park	Parks committee will discuss further phasing opportunities to advance the project. We meet with the County at the liaison meeting and will continue meeting with the OPUD parks consultant to try and provide some recreation features at the park site.
