**AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE NO. 190.11,
ADOPTED ON NOVEMBER 1, 2003**

Be and enacted by the Board of Directors of the Olivehurst Public Utility District as follows:

Ordinance No. 190.11 was adopted on November 1, 2003, establishing a system of rates and charges for sewer service by Olivehurst Public Utility District.


The District has, by Resolution No. 2106, adopted on December 15, 2005, established a tariff system of rates and charges, which is subject to amendment from time to time as may be determined appropriate by the Board of Directors.

The Board finds that the continuation of the system of rates and charges established in Ordinance No. 190, and carried on continuously through amendments thereof, is unduly complex and no longer required for the District and the Board has determined that a tariff method of publicizing and managing rates and charges, subject to change by resolution from time to time as deemed appropriate is superior.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED that Resolution No. 190.11 is hereby rescinded and rates and charges for sewer service as established in Resolution No. 2106 shall be continued in substitution thereof.




